Rules and Regulations

- 1. Every class which is offered herein will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the United States Equestrian Federation.
- 2. Life, Senior active and Junior active Members shall be eligible to participate at Regular Member Competitions. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Member Competitions upon payment of a \$30 show pass. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1)leadline, 2)exhibitions, 3)games and races, 4)classes for 4-H members, 5)walk, trot, and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program), 6)opportunity classes and 7)citizens of other nations who are members in good standing of their national federation and have proof in English.
- 3. ENTRIES CLOSE:

June 8, 2017 Smithtown HuntJune 29, 2017 Gold Coast ClassicJuly 7, 2017 Suffolk ClassicAug. 17, 2017 Nassau Suffolk Horsemen'sSept. 7, 2017 Long Island Classic

If Classes are not filled, post entries will be accepted up to one hour before the class at an additional \$25 for sections requiring a combined entry fee, \$15 for all other classes. All accounts must be settled by 6:00pm Sunday of each show. Open checks will be filled in at that time. Scratch Fee \$35.

4. REFUNDS on entries will be made only upon receipt of veterinarian certificates attesting to inability of horse do to illness or injury to participate. Refunds will be mailed. There will be a \$25 office charge for all refunds.

5. Amateur certification and Pony and Junior Hunter measurements cards must be presented at the Show Office before numbers will be given out.

6. No entry will be accepted unless signed by the rider, owner/agent and coach/trainer and the required fees in negotiable funds accompany a completed entry blank.

7. Stalls will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Stalls are in a permanent barn with doors. \$40 per day.

8. In order to remove any animal or equip from show grounds, a release must be obtained from the Show Office.

9. All prize money will be paid by check and may be picked up at the Secretary's Office a half hour after the completion of a division. The horse show's responsibility terminates at that time. All checks will be void after 30 days.

10. Rider or trainer conflicts will not be honored.

11. Dogs and other pets must be on a leash at all times.

12. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes & limit courtesy circles.

13. The Long Island Horse Shows Inc., Old Field Farm Ltd. and the County of Suffolk, their management officials and employees shall not be liable for any injury to a person or property of any exhibitor, rider, spectator, visitor, groom or any other person by reason of any event occurring during the course of the shows.

14. Should any questions arise that are not provided in the rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.

15. Negative Coggins Test dated within the calendar year required.

16. A fee of \$50 plus collection fees will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.

Exhibitors who submitted non-negotiable checks in previous years must pay cash.

17. Rings are: Main Ring- & New Ring 260 x 170 All weather footing- Pony Ring- Sand 110x220

18. All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, Jumper & hunter seat eq. (except those activities enumerated in GR 901.1 items 1-9) must be properly identified & must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA.

19. All classes must be entered at the secretary office. If you enter a class at the ingate, you will be charged an additional \$20 fee.

20. Horses must be entered in the horse show in order to enter warm-ups.

21. Veterinary measurements will be done by appt. Call 516-297-1539.

22. It is compulsory for riders in all classes where jumping is required & when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use & carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. See GR801.2

Motorized Vehicle Statement: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent)s), legal guardian(s) or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and /or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

SHORT STIRRUP: A rider who enters and shows in the Short Stirrup Division (Eq. or Hunter) shall not be eligible to enter any other division at that show. Riders must be age 12 or under as of December 1st of the current show year. In order to split the section 8 are needed, at least 3 in each section. Section to be split by age. 10 and under and 11-12. Permissible test for the Short Stirrup Eq. is USEF Hunter Seat Eq. Test #1. (Halt and/or back). Courses for all short stirrup classes must consist of at least six (6) cross rails not to exceed 18". In the Short Stirrup Hunter Section, courses must contain 1 change of direction CHILDRENS & ADULT AMATEUR HUNTERS: To be run according to Zone 2 specifications

LIHSAA CHILDRENS HUNTER HORSE: Rider 15 & under & 16 to 17

LIHSAA ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER: Younger & Older divisions

LIHSAA CHILDRENS HUNTER PONIES: Small/Medium & Large

LOW CHILDRENS, LOW ADULT HUNTERS, LOW PONY HUNTERS: Combining divisions is allowed if one section has less than three entries.

LIHSAA LOW CHILDRENS HUNTERS: Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th Birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Two sections must be offered: Ponies and Horses. If there are less than 3 entries in either the Pony section or the Horse section, both sections must be combined. Ponies to jump 2' and horses to jump 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the Children's Hunter division or any class/section where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception 3'0" Equitation). May combine with Low Adult Hunters if one section has less than 3 entries.

LIHSAA LOW ADULT HUNTERS: Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th Birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Height of Fences 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into any division or any class/section where fences exceed 2'9" (Exception 3'0" Equitation). May combine with Low Childrens Hunters if one section has less than 3 entries. L.I.H.S.A.A JAMES RICE DERBY

Horse and ponies may not be entered in any To be run at two heights: 2'6" & 3' sections. Open Junior, Amateur, and Professional Riders. A rider is not limited to the number of horses he/she may ride. To be judged on style and performance. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. Spreads not to exceed fence height. The First round to be over a Classictype course of 8-12 fences. The top 12 will return to jump a Second round. The Second round may include handy-type elements such as roll-backs and hand galloping and trotting a fence. Scores will be added to determine the winners. Three horses must complete the first round in order to fill the division. A rider must compete in a minimum of three James Rice Derby's at the same height to be eligible for a year end award. The year end awards may be split into Professional and Junior/Amateur sections if entries warrant.

Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation class.

LIHSAA LOW ADULT EQUITATION: Open to adult amateurs. Fences 2'. Riders may not cross enter into the Adult Hunter division or any class/section where fences exceed 2'6" LIHSAA PRE-MINI 2'6" MEDAL EQUITATION: Exhibitors must be Junior Riders who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3' or higher equitation class. 1st through 6th place will receive points as 7-5-4-3-2-1. To be shown over a lower and/ or modified version of the courses used in the National Medal Classes (3'6" and 3' classes). Riders may not compete in any classes exceeding 2'6" at the same show that they compete in the Pre-Mini Division. Fences not to exceed 2'6. May combine Pre Mini and Medium Adult Equitation if one section has less than 3 entries. LIHSAA MEDIUM ADULT MEDAL DIVISION: Exhibitors must be Adult Amateur Riders who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3' or higher equitation class. 1st through 6th place will receive points as 7-5-4-3-2-1. To be shown over a lower and/ or modified version of the courses used in the National Medal Classes (3'6" and 3' classes). Riders may not compete in any classes exceeding 2'6" at the same show that they compete in the Medium Adult Division. Fences not to exceed 2'6. May combine Pre Mini and Medium Adult Eq. if less than 3 entries. HUGH J.B. CASSIDY III MEDIUM ADULT MACLAY: Open to adult amateur riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences at 2'6" with or without wings. A

minimum of 12 riders if available is required to show at a walk, trot and canter. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. The Under Saddle shall count 50%. Test 1-19. Only one rider per horse.

LIHSAA HIGH ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION: Riders in the following adult equitation classes may not compete in classes where fences exceed 3'6" at the same show. Height of Fences 3'0". May combine Mini and High Adult Equitation if one section has less than 3 entries.

HUGH J.B. CASSIDY III HIGH ADULT MACLAY: Open to adult amateur riders. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences at 3'0" with or without wings. Only one rider per horse.

HIGH ADULT PHA: To be run in accordance with current PHA equitation rules. Rider must be a Member of the LIPHA as of the date he/she competes in an Adult PHA Medal Class in order for points to count. Fences at 3'0". The LIPHA sponsors Equitation classes in several divisions. These classes may be held at any show, USEF member or non-member as long as LIPHA permission has been obtained.

LIHSAA MINI MEDAL DIVISION: Combine Mini and High Adult Eq. if one section has less than 3.

HUGH J.B. CASSIDY III MINI MACLAY: Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in a any 3'6" or higher equitation class prior to the closing date for entries for this show. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight obstacles not exceeding 3' with or without wings. A minimum of 12 riders if available is required to show at a walk, trot and canter. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse. The Under Saddle performance of those riders selected to show under saddle shall count 50%. Tests 1-19. Only one rider per horse.

ROBERT HOSKINS MINI MEDAL: Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and who have not won three (3) blue ribbons in any 3'6" or higher equitation class prior to the closing date for entries for this show. To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles not exceeding 3'0" which must include a combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction. Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required. Tests 1-19. Only one rider per horse.

ROSS REISNER MINI PHA: To be run in accordance with current PHA equitation rules. Rider must be a Member of the LIPHA as of the date he/she competes in an Mini PHA Medal Class in order for points to count. Fences at 3'. The LIPHA sponsors Equitation classes in several divisions. These classes may be held at any show, USEF member or non-member as long as LIPHA permission has been obtained.

LIHSAA OPEN MEDAL DIVISION

A Champion and Reserve high point open equitation award will be given at the end of each LIHSAA Calendar year. A riders pts are calculated on the number of pts accumulated in the Medal, Maclay & PHA classes. Riders Points will be averaged based on the number of horse shows competed in.

LIHSAA JUMPERS: Open to horses and ponies. Fences 0.95 to 1.00 m (3' to 3'3"). CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1 of the current competition year and adults who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies. Height of Fences: Low Child/Adult .90m (2'11) to 1:00m (3'3) High Child/Adult 1.10m (3'7) to 1.15m (3'9) Cross Entry: Riders may not compete in any other class at the same competition where fences exceed 1.15m (3'9") except the USEF Talent Search Class, level 1*,2*,3*. Horses may show at 1.40m (4'7") or below with another rider.

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
