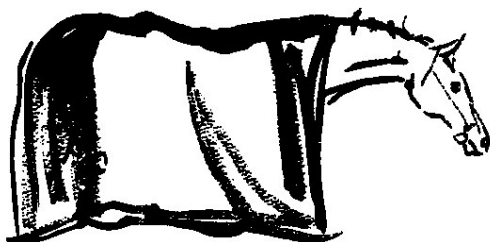

**HIGH POINT AWARDS** will be presented to the horse or pony in a hunter or jumper division with the most points in the same hunter or jumper division for all shows. Equitation points go to the rider who has the most points in the same equitation division for all shows, regardless of what horse they ride.

To be eligible, horse/rider must compete at three shows in the same division.

**ENTRY FEES:** The deadline for pre-entries, e-mailed or on [horseshowing.com](http://horseshowing.com) is 9 PM the Thursday before the show & will be Strictly Enforced. When a horse show extends the courtesy of taking entries over the phone it is with the understanding that said entries will be paid. Make checks payable to LIHS - Pre-Entries \$25 per class unless otherwise noted – Post Entries \$30 per class. M&S, NES classes require an additional fee for points to count.

**ENTRY AGREEMENT - Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification.** This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing. I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following: I AGREE that the "Competition" as used herein includes the USHJA and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliates. I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, handler, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm"). I AGREE to hold harmless and release the USHJA and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the USHJA or the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the USHJA or the Competition. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the USHJA and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the USHJA strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition BY SIGNING ABOVE, I AGREE to be bound by the terms and provisions of this entry blank and all terms submitting this Agreement. ## Rules and Regulations

1. Every class which is offered herein will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the United States Equestrian Federation.
2. **ENTRIES:** Pre-entries will be taken by email or [horseshowing.com](http://horseshowing.com) until 9:00 PM the Thursday preceding the show date. Entries are the responsibility of the entrant & must be received by the above deadline. No one will be permitted to perform without payment of all fees. All exhibitors must sign a release form & a parent/guardian's signature is required for all Junior riders. All accounts must be settled by 6:00pm Sunday of each show. Open checks will be filled in at that time.
3. REFUNDS on entries will be made only upon receipt of veterinarian certificates attesting to inability of horse to show to illness or injury to participate. There will be a \$15 charge for refunds. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be made by mail.
4. Schooling will be from 7:00 to 8:00 AM and during breaks.
5. No entry will be accepted unless signed by the rider, owner/agent and coach/trainer and the required fees in negotiable funds.
6. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide or move any class. Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined or cancelled.
7. Martingales are not permitted in any flat classes with the exception of Pre Walk Trot. Flashes will not be permitted in equitation or hunters. Boots, bandages or wraps are not permitted in hunter or pleasure. A \$5 fee must be paid in order for NES points to count.
8. Stalls will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Stalls are in a permanent barn with doors.
9. Rider or trainer conflicts will not be honored.
10. Dogs and other pets must be on a leash at all times.
11. The Long Island Horse Shows Inc., Old Field Farm Ltd. and the County of Suffolk, their management officials and employees shall not be liable for any injury to a person or property of any exhibitor, rider, spectator, visitor, groom or any other person by reason of any event occurring during the course of the shows.
12. Should any questions arise that are not provided in the rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
13. A fee of \$25 plus collection fees will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
14. Exhibitors who submitted non-negotiable checks in previous years must pay cash.
15. Main Ring- 260 x 170 All weather footing-Ring 2 110x220 sand.
16. All classes must be entered at the secretary office. If you enter a class at the ingate, you will be charged an additional \$20 fee.
17. Schooling shows are not eligible for USEF points. They are a day of friendly unrecognized competitions for the benefit of all competitors.
